## Preschool Teacher

**DEFINITION:** Under supervision of site administrator, work independently and collaboratively in performing varied tasks to accomplish the goals and objectives of the Preschool Teacher.

### EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

1. Assist classroom staff in maintaining a safe, clean, and healthy work environment
2. Support classroom staff in the implementation of developmentally appropriate curriculum and assessment process
3. Model appropriate behavior and interact in a positive, friendly and courteous manner with children, staff, families and community volunteers in order to build and foster responsive relationships
4. Assist in the supervision and management of children in the classroom.
5. Develop trusting relationships with children and families.
6. Preparing classroom for school year.
7. Preparing or creating curriculum for both inside and outside classrooms.
8. Routinely changing monthly themes and classroom supplies.
9. Create positive learning experiences in both inside and outside classrooms.
10. Creating and maintaining bulletin boards in classroom.
11. Create a stimulating, positive environment.
12. Plan, supervise and attend various preschool events throughout the school year.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be mature, friendly adult who is sensitive to the needs of children and families with the ability to/knowledge of:

1. Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
2. Organize tasks.
3. Works well independently and with fellow teachers.

4. Ability to work with individual and groups of children ages 2.5-5, supporting social emotional, physical, and cognitive growth
5. Take suggestions in a positive manner.
6. Learn Children's Program rules, methods, routines, and processes.
7. Help maintain accurate and complete records in compliance with Community Care Licensing.
8. Establish and maintain harmonious relationships with staff, parents, and collaborative agencies.

**APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:**

- 24 Early Childhood Education units (or related units in early childhood education or child development)
- OR a valid Child Development Teacher Permit
- OR Associate's degree in Early Childhood Education
- Preferable- at least six months of work experience in a licensed child care center or comparable group child care program (at least three hours per day for a minimum of 50 days in a six-month period)
- CPR certified
- Capable of lifting 20 pounds.
- Valid California Driver License and clean DMV record
- Pre-employment Criminal background check required
- Pre-employment drug test
- Pre-employment TB test
- Up to date vaccination records (COVID immunization preferred)
- 1-3 year contract, probable

**COMPENSATION:**

- One hour PTO for every 20 hours worked.
- Flexible hours and days off
- Part time- opportunity for more than part time
- Daily schedule 7:30/8:00am-1pm, Monday- Friday. (Number of hours depends on number of children in attendance)
- Probationary period of 90 days starting at \$17.00. Increase after Probationary period ends.
